

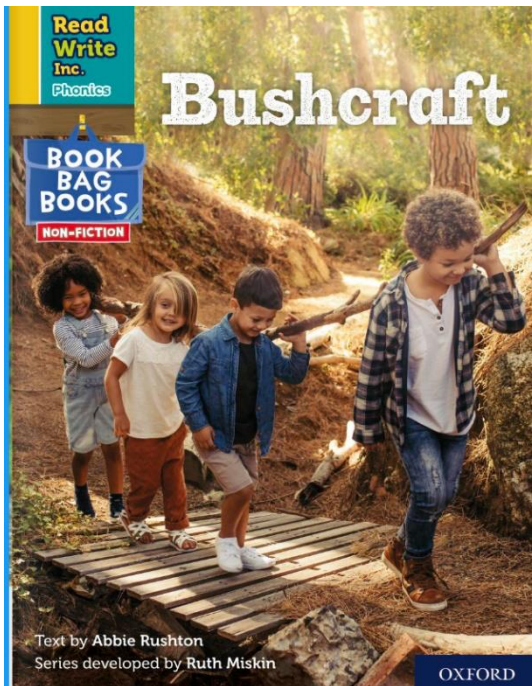

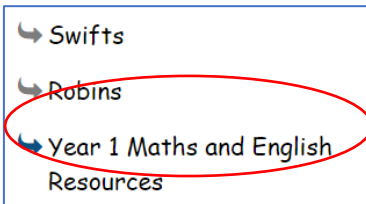


Questions to read and answer

Ask your child to read the sentences and choose the correct answer.

3. You can paddle in a **brook** / **den** / **tent**.
4. You will have to pick up lots of **arrows** / **mud** / **sticks** so that you can cook.
