

Dear Parents,

Although we strongly discourage children bringing mobile phones to school, we do appreciate as they reach Year 5/Year 6, some of them may be coming to and leaving school independently. For safety reasons, you may feel reassured if your child has a mobile phone with them for their journey.

If this is the case and you give consent to your child bringing in a mobile phone to school, we will require you to complete the permission slip below. If your child brings a mobile phone to school, they must hand it in to their teacher on arrival who will put the phone in a named sealed bag. The phone will then be stored, in a locked cupboard, in the school office until the end of the day, when it will be returned to your child. Your child must not keep the phone with them during the school day.

If your child uses their phone inappropriately on the school site, you will be contacted by the school and sanctions will be discussed.
