Dear Parents,

Due to government guidelines, these events have not been able to happen. However, to mark and celebrate their time with us at Bramingham, we are arranging a separate event for the children.

On Tuesday 13th July, a 'Farewell Festival' has been arranged for our Year 6 children. The event will be held between 5pm and 7pm and it will take place outdoors on the school field. There will be music, dancing, face painting, free games stalls with prizes and a photobooth (provided by the Friends of Bramingham). It will be an opportunity for the whole year group to get together and enjoy the evening.

There will be a marquee with seats which means that the event will be able to go ahead, regardless of the weather. We will provide the children with a cone of chips and drinks on the evening.
