English

Children will be exploring characterisation through the story 'The Tunnel'. They will be writing their own warning story. They will be beginning to use dialogue in their written work.

We will be looking at nonchronological report writing and they will produce their own report all about the Bramingham area. **Class reader:** The Boy at the back of the Class.

Music

Children will learn to play the violin by plucking and bowing the open strings in different rhythmic patterns.

Art

Children will learn about different techniques used by artists to create portraits. They will base their own self-portrait on the work of Craig and Karl.

Science

Children will compare and group together different kinds of rocks based on their appearance. They will also learn how fossils are formed and recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

Autumn 2

Year 3: How did we get here?

Geography

Children will be exploring how the Bramingham area has changed and why people travelled to Bramingham.

PSHE

We will look at how friendships support wellbeing and what positive friendships look like. We will look at how to seek support if we feel lonely.

Computing

Children will be building and using branching databases to group objects using yes/no questions.

RE

Children will explore the Jewish festivals of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. They will look at how food is used as symbolism in a Sedar meal.

Maths

Adding and subtracting 2-digit and 3-digit numbers. Equal grouping and using arrays. Looking at multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10, Dividing by 3 and 4.

We will be learning the 8 times table.

Children will be following instructions, naming parts of the body, identifying colours and say what they are wearing in French.
