As we approach the end of the first half term, we cannot express strongly enough how proud we are of the children and how well they have adjusted to the different ways of working in school. Throughout the half term, we have visited classes and the children are enthusiastic and keen to share their work. Our Early Years children have settled in beautifully and they have mastered the routines of school life so well.

Despite some of the restrictions, it is wonderful to see our children engaging in exciting learning activities. Some of the highlights from this half term include, Year 6 researching to create fact files on Europe, Year 5 dressing up for their Victorian day as part of their history work, Year 4 making chocolate bars, Year 3 designing and making their own cushions as part of their design technology work, Year 2 producing some beautiful artwork based on the artist, Paul Klee's, work and Year 1 learning to wash clothes using a washboard and soap. 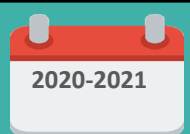
Half Term begins 26th October with children returning 2nd November.
