SWIMMING LESSONS – Hedgehogs

Hedgehog class will resume their swimming classes on Wednesday 20th April 2022. The sessions continue at Lea Manor Recreation Centre on Wednesday afternoons from 1:30pm to 2:30pm. Lessons start on our first day back to school after the Easter break.

Hedgehog Class lessons will take place over the following dates:

Summer Term 2022	Wednesday 20 th April to	6 weeks
Half Term 5	Wednesday 25 th May 2022	

In order to cover the cost of transport, we kindly ask you for a voluntary contribution. The cost for each child for the half term, will be **£2.00**, as we are now able to use our school minibuses. **Please could you log onto your child's Eduspot account to add the voluntary contribution by Friday 29th April 2022.**

Please can you ensure that if it is your child's swimming day, they come to school prepared. Your child will need:

- a towel,
- a comb or hairbrush,
- a one-piece plain swimming costume for the girls
- a pair of swimming trunks, not shorts, for the boys
- a bag for their wet costume and towel, along with a **large** plastic bag for clothes, as your child will change and then transport their clothes to the pool side,

For those children who have inhalers, class teachers will ensure they are taken to the pool.

The children will not be allowed to wear jewellery of any kind, including earrings. However, if earrings are worn the child must be able to remove them by themselves. Hair must be tied back from the face and for those with long hair, it is preferable they wear a swimming hat.

Swimming is part of the National Curriculum, therefore it is expected that every child will swim. We do however understand that you may want reassurance into how swimming is managed safely in light of Covid. Active Luton have shared their Covid risk assessment outlining their safety measures and this is available on the school website for you to read.
