It's a Wonderful Life, London Coliseum, English National Opera

We are thrilled to have been offered the exciting opportunity of free tickets to the London Coliseum to see the classic Christmas story, It's a Wonderful Life. We will be treated to an operatic adaptation of the Frank Capra film of the same name, which transports the audience to the idyllic little town of Bedford Falls, where it is a white Christmas.

The London Coliseum is a theatre in St Martin's Lane, Westminster, built as one of London's largest and most luxurious "family" variety theatres.

We will be attending a 'relaxed' performance, an inclusive environment, making noise during the performance is permitted & encouraged! Any significant sudden loud sound effects or flashing light are removed for the performance and there is an opportunity to meet the orchestra before the show starts and hear the sections play.

Details

The performance starts at 11am, so we will need an early start. Children will need to be in school by 8am to leave at 8.15am promptly.

Please provide a packed lunch for your child and please remember no fizzy drinks or sweets. *(If your child is entitled to a free school meal you will shortly receive a text asking if you would like a packed lunch to be provided by the school kitchen. Please reply promptly so as the correct number of lunches can be ordered)*

The children will be travelling via coach to the theatre and will return to school at approximately 3.30pm.

The cost of the theatre tickets has been covered and we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £12.92 to cover the transport costs. Unfortunately, if we are unable to raise enough funds it will be necessary to cancel the trip.
