Dear Parents,

In year 3 we will be exploring, Stone Age to the Iron Age as part of our History curriculum.

To enhance the children's learning, we have arranged a visit to the Chiltern Open Air Museum in Chalfont St Giles, Buckinghamshire. We have visited the museum many times in the past and it has always proved to be an exciting and worthwhile trip. We will have a tour of the museum and a practical workshop takes place in the Iron Age roundhouse . During this workshop children will learn about Iron Age settlements, grind grain and create flatbreads which are cooked over the open fire in a replica roundhouse; they create butter from cream and fashion clay pottery. There are additional activities relating to the growing of crops and the evidence of Iron Age jewellery.

The trip will take place on Thursday 3rd March 2022. We will leave school at 9.00am and return in time for the end of the school day. Please can all children wear school uniform, including a warm coat and trainers, wellies or comfy shoes as they will be walking around the outdoor museum throughout the day. All children will require a packed lunch, no fizzy drinks please. **If your child is entitled to a free school meal,** the kitchen can organise a packed lunch for them. This does not include a drink which you will need to provide for your child (no fizzy drinks). **We will text you nearer the time to ask if your child requires a packed lunch.**

The cost of this trip is £17.00 per child and we are asking for a voluntary contribution of this amount. Unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, the trip will not be able to take place.

Please could you log onto your child's Eduspot account to add your voluntary contribution along with ticking the parental consent box no later than Friday, 25th February 2022. We hope you will agree this will be a fantastic learning opportunity for your child.
