SWIMMING LESSONS - Foxes

All children from September will be going swimming at Lea Manor Leisure Centre throughout next academic year. Year 3 swimming sessions are on Friday from 9.30 am until 11.30 am. Autumn half term 1 sessions will run from Friday 7th September until Friday 19th October, 2018 (inclusive).

In order to maximise learning time we have decided to send each class on alternate weeks which will mean more time swimming and less time travelling! They will get a double session in the pool each fortnight. Current Foxes class swimming session will start from Friday 7th September 2018.

In order to cover the cost of each session and the cost of additional swimming teaching staff, we require a voluntary contribution from each child. The cost for current Foxes autumn half term 1 will be £10.68. We would appreciate payment by Friday 20th July 2018. Could you please send your payment by cheque, made payable to Bramingham Primary School, or the exact amount in cash. Thank you.

Please complete the slip below and return it with your payment by Friday 20th July. Please note cheques will not be paid in until September.

Every other Friday, the children need to bring their swimming kit which will consist of:-

- a towel.
- a comb or hair brush
- a one piece plain swimming costume for the girls
- a pair of swimming trunks, not shorts, for the boys

The children will not be allowed to wear jewellery of any kind, including earrings. However if earrings are worn the child must be able to remove them by themselves. Hair must be tied back from the face and for those with long hair it is preferable if they wear a swimming hat. Additionally, your child will not be able to attend a swimming session if they have a case of ring worm.

Swimming is part of the National Curriculum, therefore it is expected that every child will swim.

INHALERS

Please note that if your child has got an inhaler, they will need to take it swimming. They will not be allowed to swim if it is not at the poolside.
