Our topic this term is focused around farming. To enhance the learning, we have arranged a visit to Herrings Green Activity Farm, in Wilstead. We have managed to secure a fantastic programme for the day, which includes meeting farm animals, reptiles and critters as well as having the chance to watch a bird of prey display!

Covid restrictions permitting, the trip will take place on Thursday 1st July. The coach will be leaving at 9.15am and return at 3pm.
