Dear Parents,

As part of our reading programme, each child (from Year 1 to Year 6) will receive either a reading comprehension or a phonic skills workbook.

The books are intended to help your child practise key reading skills to develop and strengthen their comprehension. The books have been chosen to challenge your child at an appropriate level and will provide additional opportunities for your child to practise the skills taught in school. The reading comprehension books include a range of different genres, including fiction, non-fiction and poetry and each text is accompanied by practice questions.

How Will The Workbooks Be Used?

- Your child will bring home their workbook. Please support them in keeping the workbook safe as they will need to bring it back into school each week. We suggest once your child has completed an activity, they put the workbook in their school bag, so they remember to bring their workbook back to school.
- Each week, the teacher will explain to the children which text to focus on and which activity they need to complete. We would appreciate it if you could spend some time supporting your child by discussing the text and their answers.
- The workbook must be returned to school on a Monday as further teaching around the completed text will take place in class.
- The teacher will then set the next task for your child to complete at home.
